



## APPLYING TO WALDORF HIGH SCHOOL

We welcome your interest in applying to Waldorf High School of Massachusetts Bay. Our goal is to get to know you during the application process and for you to experience what Waldorf High School can offer you.

Students and parents are invited to visit the school and observe classes and meet faculty and students during our regularly scheduled Student/Parent Information Sessions. (Call the office for upcoming dates and to register for a session.) You can also visit our Sunday Open House in October and January.

When the school has received all the items on the Admissions Process Checklist, we will contact you about the next steps. Admissions decisions will be sent by mid March for applicants who submit their application by January 31. Applications received after the deadline are reviewed on a rolling basis. When your application process is complete, you may expect to receive a decision within two weeks.
